- 3. Applicants who passed the screening examinations are required to submit the original copies of "Documents proving your eligibility to apply", "Photocopy of main passport pages", "Certificate of English language ability" and
 - "Notes (a)~(c)", which are listed on p.6 of the Guidance for Prospective Students Global Art Practice Entrance Examinations for International Students. Please send all original copies by post with the other required admission documents by the designated deadline (expected to be around the end of November 2025, when enrollment documents will be sent out). Offers of admission will be canceled if any of the required application documents submitted online differ from the original copies, or the original copies are not submitted.
- 4. If an international applicant who passed Period 1 screening (for International students) takes an examination in Period 2 screening, he or she will not pass the examination.
